Thus, the mind-mapping tool serves as a relief to the challenges faced by students in remembering facts and figures.

Elaborating on event organizing or apply called event management, students who have the additional task of organizing school events can create picture resources to assigning tasks, creating schedules and more through the mapping concept which is making rapid strides in the west. Companies use this tool extensively as it has been proven effective in all areas of knowledge gathering.
