- Academic Transcript(s) – If you have not received your Academic Transcript at the time of application you will receive a Conditional Offer. Once you have received your Academic Transcript please email it to curtin-enquiries@slit.lk

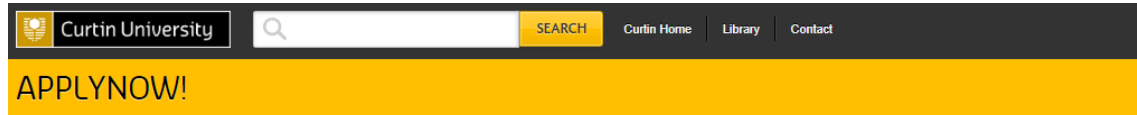

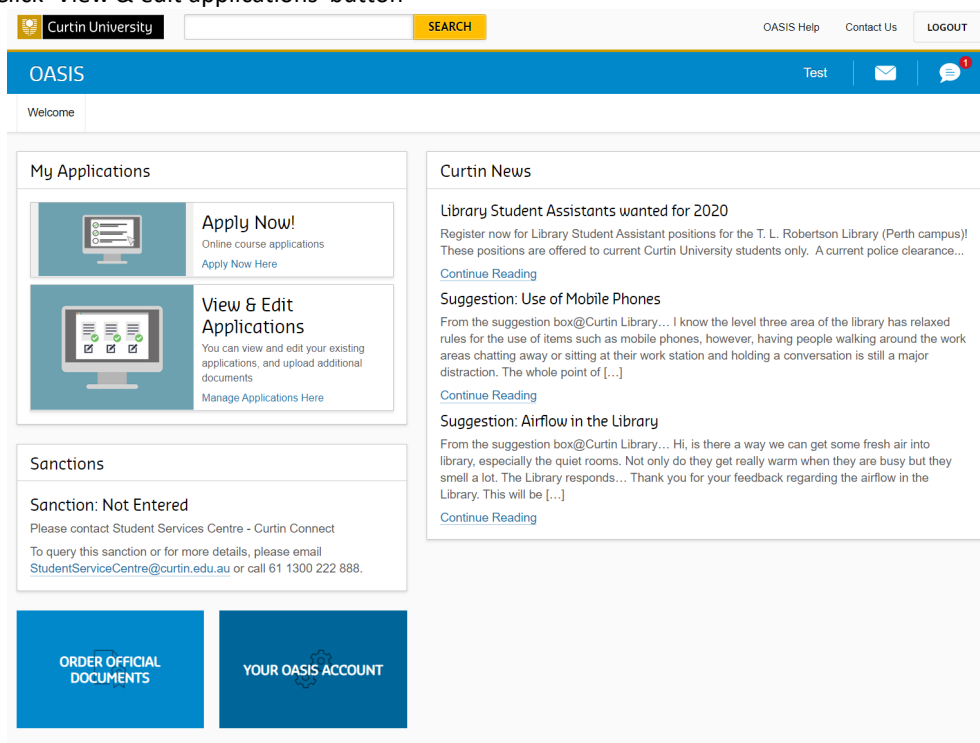
Activating your OASIS Account
